



Year 6 Overview: Summer 1 term 2020

Children will learn to communicate their ideas better to work as a team.</p> 	<p>With Mr White and our class teachers, we will continue to develop our fundamental movement skills through net and wall games:</p> <p>*UNDERARM THROW, CATCHING, STRIKING WITH A RACQUET (FOREHAND AND BACKHAND)</p> <p><u>Having developed our balance and core strength, we will be continuing with GYMNASTICS focusing on:</u></p> <p>*FLOOR SHAPES, FLOOR MOVEMENT, BENCH BALANCE, VAULT, CLIMBING AND TRAVERSING APPARATUS*</p>
	<p>Maths</p> <p>In maths this term, we will continue to personalise the arithmetic and reasoning learning with the aim of filling pupils' gaps in their knowledge.</p>  <p>After SATs, children will be conducting longer, reasoning and problem solving investigations and also learning about statistics.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>In science this term, we will be learning about evolution and inheritance. Through planning and conducting research and investigations children will identify how plants and animals (including humans) are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.</p> <p>We will look at how things have changed over time and explore how fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.</p>
<p>Enterprise</p> <p>This half-term, we will complete our Enterprise topic. This gives children the opportunity to plan and produce a long-term project with the aim of making money whilst practising their leadership and communication skills.</p> 	<p>History</p> <p>In history this term, we will be learning about the English Civil War (1642-1651)</p> <p>Pupils will examine the reason for the war and the effect that the outcome had on this country's society. In addition to this, children will study a key historical figure of the time - Oliver Cromwell.</p> 	<p>Pupils will also be taught to recognise that living things produce offspring that have similar characteristics to their parents.</p>
