


Year 3 Overview: Spring Term 2

<p>WRITING: Our focus text this half term is: <u>The Enchanted Wood</u> by Enid Blyton Through the story, the children will learn how an author entertains the reader and uses different writing styles for engagement. They will learn how to write effective sentences to help portray different feelings, atmospheres etc. to entertain the reader.</p>  <p>READING: THROUGH OUR READING SESSIONS WE WILL FOCUS ON:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Understanding the Purpose, Audience and Formality of a text.
