

Their English book is a testament to their writing ability, which has improved dramatically during their time at Ocean.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Enterprise: Make £5 Grow</p> <p>This term, pupils will be gaining an insight into the life of an entrepreneur when they try to make £5 grow. Pupils will work in groups having borrowed £5 from the school office. Throughout a series of lessons, they will plan how to best spend their money in order to make a profit. Near the end of term, the children will be given a chance to sell their wares!</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Animals Including Humans</p> <p>Pupils will learn about the main parts of the human circulatory system and how they function to deliver oxygen. Pupils will also learn about the impact of lifestyle on the human body. We will look at the effect of diet and exercise as well as the effect of drugs. Children will learn about: legal, non-harmful drugs; legal, harmful drugs, prescription drugs and illegal drugs. We will explore the impact and potential dangers of each.</p>
