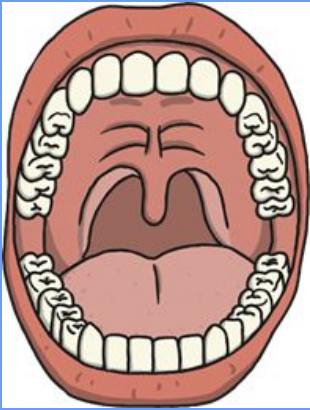


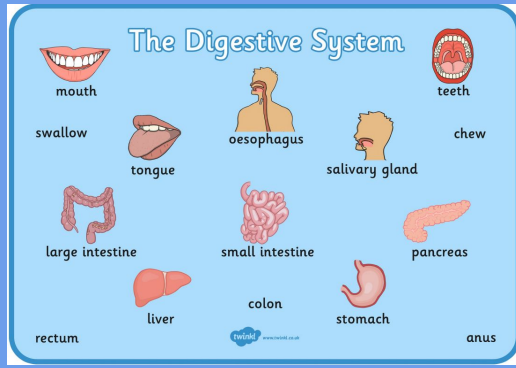
Teeth

The digestive system breaks down what you eat so that the nutrients in the food can be released to make energy.

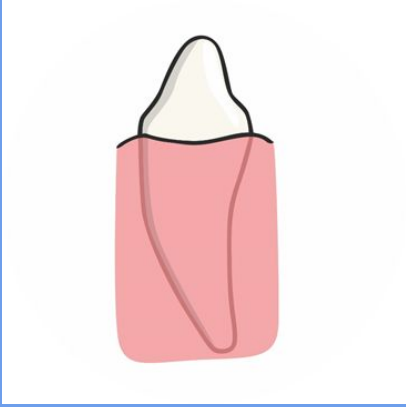
Incisor

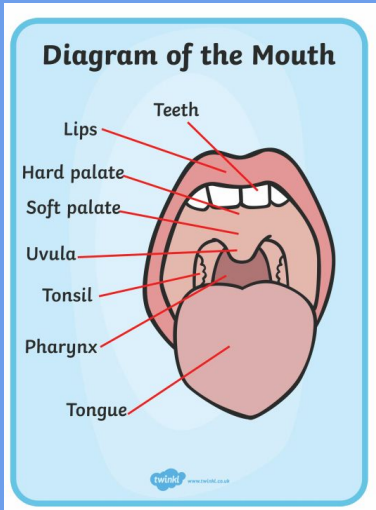
Used for chewing and grinding food.
