Dear Parent/Carer,

In the **Summer term** of this academic year, Year 6 have the opportunity to visit **New Forest Activities in Beaulieu** for a residential stay of **2 nights and 3 days** of adventure and fun.

We have booked to visit the week following pupils' SATs tests; this serves as an exciting reward for their hard work whilst also being a memorable send-off for our departing Year 6 cohort.

The dates for this visit are **Wednesday 17th May 2023 – Friday 19th May 2023**.

This residential will take place at **New Forest Activities in Beaulieu**. The children will be transported to and from the venue by coach. The **cost** of this residential is **£199 all inclusive**. The school is able to cover the cost of the coach.

During the residential visit, children will be provided with:

- Four adventurous half-day activities and all required equipment
- Fully qualified instructors
- Evening entertainment
- Three meals a day, two meals on the first and final days
- Two nights' camping accommodation
- Access to washing facilities
