This residential will take place at **New Forest Activities in Beaulieu**. The children will be transported to and from the venue by coach. The **cost** of this residential is **£249 all inclusive**. The school is able to cover the cost of the coach to try and keep prices to a minimum. .

- Three meals a day, two meals on the first and final days
