

	<p>In maths, we will focus upon the following areas throughout the term:</p> <p><u>MULTIPLICATION AND DIVISION:</u> *Continuing to recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables. *Learning how to use the formal written method for multiplication and division.</p> <p><u>MONEY AND STATISTICS</u> Additionally, children will complete the daily arithmetic challenges, and have the opportunity to regularly practise their times tables.</p> 	<p style="text-align: right;"><u>ART:</u> In art, we will be studying <u>*ancient cave paintings</u> and then creating our own versions.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><u>MUSIC:</u> In music, we will be learning to play the Ukulele, learning the chords C, F, G & G7 to play simple melodies.</p>
