

Creating our own character description of Mrs Twit. Learning about coastal erosion as part of our physical geography. <p style="text-align: center;">Click here to see the Learning Journey Map</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>In maths, we will focus upon the following areas throughout the term:</p> <p>MULTIPLICATION AND DIVISION: *We will continue to consolidate our understanding of the formal written method for multiplication and division.</p> <p>MONEY AND STATISTICS</p> <p>LENGTH AND PERIMETER</p> <p>Additionally, children will complete the daily arithmetic challenges, and have the opportunity to regularly practise their times tables.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Creative</p> <p style="text-align: center;">ART:</p> <p>In art, we will be studying the artist George Seurat and then creating our own minibeast painting in the pointillism style.</p>  <p style="text-align: center;">MUSIC:</p> <p>In music, we will be learning to play the Ukulele, learning the chords C, F, G & G7 to play simple melodies.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">DT - COOKING:</p> <p>In DT, we will be learning about food and nutrition.
