Dear Parents/Carers

For our science learning in Year 3, we cover a broad range of topics, including rocks and fossils, forces and magnets, and light. In order to revise what we have and will have learnt by the end of this academic year, we would like to take the children to **Winchester Science Centre** on **Thursday 13**th **June 2024.**

While there, the children will be given time to explore the exhibitions, take part in a rockets workshop run by the staff and also get to go and explore the amazing planetarium.

In order to arrive on time, we need to leave school at 9:00am that morning and so therefore ask for children to be dropped off promptly by **8:45am at the latest** on that morning. We will be leaving the centre at 2:00pm to be back at school for the **usual pick up time of 3.20pm** (traffic dependent). If there are any delays, the school office will aim to let you know as soon as possible.

We hope that the children will be given the chance to visit the gift shop so can bring up to a **maximum of £5 to spend**. Spending in the shop is optional. We cannot accept any responsibility for lost money or items on the trip.

In order for us to cover the costs of the trip, we ask for a **contribution of £17.00** per child. Please note that the trip will not be able to go ahead if the relevant funding cannot be met. Payment can be made via School Money and payment to be made by 31 May 2023.
