

This will also include time looking at prime numbers, factors and multiples.</p> <p>We will also begin our fraction studies for the year, looking at equivalent fractions, comparing and order fractions and adding and subtracting them.</p> <p>Throughout the year, there will be a comprehensive arithmetic programme in place, where all aspects of mathematical learning, including the 4 operations, fractions, decimals and percentages and revision of key fluency facts.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>The English Civil War</i></p> <p>This term, we will be learning about the English Civil War.
